## Camp Positions 2012

### **General Information: Unless other wise indicated all positions require:**

- Ability to work from June 10, 2012 to August 24, 2012
- CPR, First Aid, Pennsylvania background checks, and a Physical in the last 12 months
- Ability and willingness to fill in as needed in any area of camp life for which you are qualified including some weekend duties.
- All Specialists Positions will work with both Day and Resident Campers and can live on camp or off camp.

### Resident Camp Positions

*Must Live On Site*

#### **Resident Camp Director**

**When:** June 4, 2012 to August 14, 2012

**Minimum Age:** 18 YEARS OF AGE (21 PREFERRED)

**Special Requirements:** Clean Driving Record

**Salary:** \$275 to \$300 per week

**Benefits:** Meals and housing provided.

**Description:** Responsible for supervision of six Resident Camp Counselors and 4 Junior Camp Counselors. Weekly scheduling of classes, evening programs, staff duties and cabin duties is a major obligation of this position. This position requires that the person live on site. Other responsibilities include, but are not limited to; meal supervision, cleaning, cabin checks and general entertainment.

#### **Cabin Counselor**

**When:** June 10, 2012 to August 14, 2012

**Minimum Age:** 18 (3 male & 3 female positions are available)

**Salary:** \$180 - \$205 per week

**Benefits:** Meals and housing provided.

**Description:** Live with and supervise campers in cabin, ages 7 to 12. This position includes program responsibilities assisting Specialists during classes, planning cabin/free time, singing, dancing, acting, and evening programs. Daily chores and duties are also required of this position. Lifeguard certification is a plus.

## Day Camp Positions

*Housing and meals available if needed*

### Day Camp Director

**When:** June 4 2012 to August 24, 2012

**Minimum Age:** 18 YEARS OF AGE (21 PREFERRED)

**Special Requirements:** Clean Driving Record

**Salary:** \$295 to \$330 per week

**Benefits:** Lunch and transportation provided.

**Description:** Responsible for all program development and scheduling of day camp, supervision of staff and day campers, organizing bus stops and field trips. Day camp is made up of 80-100 campers a week age 5-12 and Teen Adventure Camp ages 13 to 15. You will work closely with the Leadership team, Day Campers and families.

### Senior Day Camp Counselor

**When:** June 10, 2012 to August 24, 2012

**Minimum Age:** 18 (4 Positions Available)

**Special Requirements:** Clean Driving Record

**Salary:** \$200 to \$225 per week

**Benefits:** Lunch and Transportation provided.

**Description:** Supervise up to 20 children per week ages 5-12. This position includes program responsibilities assisting Specialists during classes, planning free time, singing, dancing, acting and general problem solving. Daily chores and duties are also required of this position. Lifeguard certification is a plus. The hours for this position are Monday through Friday 7:30 a.m. to 6:00 p.m (hours vary if you live on site) Includes bus stop responsibilities.

### Camp Counselor

**When:** June 10, 2012 to August 24, 2012

**Minimum Age:** 16 (2 male & 2 female positions are available)

**Salary:** \$160 to \$175 per week

**Benefits:** Housing and Meals. Must live on site.

**Description:** Provide assistance to Senior Day Counselor during the day. Assist and live with cabin in evening. Provide assistance with all aspects of programming, chores and daily duties. Must have high energy, be responsible and have a commitment to work in an outdoor environment on a daily basis.

## Teen Camp Positions

*Must Live On Site (Except Teen Adventure)*

### Teen Adventure Specialist

**When:** June 10, 2012 to August 24, 2012

**Minimum Age:** 18 YEARS OF AGE (21 PREFERRED) (1 Male & 1 Female position available)

**Special Requirements:** Clean Driving Record

**Salary:** \$220-\$245 per week

**Benefits:** Lunch and Transportation provided. Housing and meals are available.

**Description:** Plan and implement adventure based activities for teen day campers. Work directly with partner to supervise approximately 15 campers per week. Some weeks may include one overnight campout on-site that you must be present for, and one field trip. As a counselor in this position it is expected that you and your co-counselor coordinate and lead a majority of your activities. This position requires tremendous physical effort, leadership, creativity, dedication and responsibility.

## Teen Camp Positions (continued)

### Teen Resident Camp Counselor (Extreme)

**When:** June 10, 2012 to August 10, 2012

**Minimum Age:** 18 YEARS OF AGE (21 PREFERRED) (1 Male & 1 Female position available)

**Special Requirements:** Advanced First Aid or Wilderness First Aid, Clean Driving Record.

**Salary:** \$220-\$245 per week

**Benefits:** Housing and meals. Must live on-site.

**Description:** Counselors will work with Teen Resident Camp (Extreme).

Plan and implement off site activities for teen campers. Counselor must be willing to participate in the adventure activities. You will be required to live in a cabin with the campers each week and will stay in a tent during on or off-site activities. Prior experience with teenagers and summer camp work is a must. Ropes course experience and leadership training work is desired.

### Service Camp Counselor

**When:** June 10, 2012 to August 10, 2012

**Minimum Age:** 21 YEARS OF AGE (1 Female, 1 Male Position Available)

**Special Requirements:** Clean Driving Record

**Salary:** \$220-\$245 per week

**Benefits:** Housing and meals. Must live on-site.

**Description:** Service Camp is a program which allows for teenagers to learn and partake in different service projects in the community and around camp. The days will be spent doing the service projects, typically from 9am – 4pm and then you and the group will return to the general camp activities enjoying a swim before dinner and participating in the evening program. You will be required to stay in a cabin in the evenings with the male or female campers from the Service Camp program and the male or female campers. We will be hiring a total of two staff for the Service Camp. One must be a male and the other must be a female. Experience working with teens is a must. Experience with community service, maintenance and leadership is preferred. **Be advised that many of the service projects do require manual labor and it is hard work!**

## Program Specialists

*Housing and meals available if needed*

### Adventure Games Specialist

**When:** June 10, 2012 to August 24, 2012

**Minimum Age:** 18 YEARS OF AGE (21 preferred)

**Salary:** \$210 - \$235 per week

**Benefits:** Lunch and Transportation, housing and meals available

**Special Requirements:** Clean Driving Record, belay trained and knowledge ropes course

**Description:** Plan and implement outdoor and adventure based games and activities for campers ages 5 to 17. Knowledge of team building, hiking, fishing, canoeing, and outdoor activities to be presented in 45 minute time blocks. Background in instructing groups of 15 to 20 campers

### Nature Specialist

**When:** June 10, 2012 to August 24, 2012

**Minimum Age:** 18 YEARS OF AGE (21 PREFERRED)

**Salary:** \$210 - \$235 per week

**Benefits:** Lunch and Transportation is provided, housing and meals available.

**Description:** Plan and implement activities for campers, age's 5 to 15 in 1 hour blocks. Need to have background in instructing 15 to 20 kids at a time. Knowledge of the environment in this area needed; recycling and earth related programming a plus. Comfortable working with live animals (frogs, snakes, turtles, salamanders) Camp counselors assist in programs.

## Program Specialists (continued)

### Outdoor Living Skills Specialist

**When:** June 10, 2012 to August 24, 2012

**Minimum Age:** 18 YEARS OF AGE (21 PREFERRED)

**Salary:** \$210 - \$235 per week

**Benefits:** Lunch and Transportation is provided, housing and meals available.

**Description:** Plan and implement activities for campers, age's 5 to 15 in 1 hour blocks. Knowledge of knot tying, fire and shelter building, survival skills and orienteering is a must. Need to have background in instructing 15 to 20 kids at a time. Camp counselors assist in programs.

### Ropes/ Leadership Development

**When:** June 10, 2012 to August 24, 2012

**Minimum Age:** 21

**Salary:** \$275.00 to \$300 per week

**Benefits:** Lunch and Transportation is provided, housing and meals are available.

**Description:** Plan and implement ropes course, climbing wall, and group interaction activities for campers, age's 5 to 17 in 1 or 2 hour blocks. Knowledge of ropes courses, belay experience, team initiatives and group work. Ropes Course experience required.

### Arts and Crafts Specialist

**When:** June 10, 2012 to August 24, 2012

**Minimum Age:** 18 YEARS OF AGE (21 PREFERRED)

**Salary:** \$210 - \$235 per week

**Benefits:** Lunch and Transportation provided housing and meals available.

**Description:** Plan and implement activities for campers, ages 5 to 15 in 1 hour blocks. Camp counselors assist in programs. Need to have background in instructing 15 to 20 kids at a time. Arts and Crafts knowledge and experience required. Pottery and kiln experience a plus.

## Aquatics

### Aquatics Director

**When:** June 4, 2012 to August 24, 2012

**Minimum Age: 21**

**Special Requirements:** WSI or YMCA equivalent training, Lifeguarding, Supervision Experience and Certified Pool

and Spa Operator preferred and clean driving record

**Salary:** \$275 - \$305 per week

**Benefits:** Meals and Housing Provided if needed

**Description:** The position will oversee pool and water front and includes supervising lifeguards, scheduling of pool and water front activities. Implements swim lessons, pool games, and evening activities. Maintain all equipment including sand filtration system and pool chemicals. Provide transportation support to Day Camp.

### Lifeguard

**When:** June 10, 2012 to August 24, 2012

**Minimum Age:** 16

**Special Requirements:** Life Guarding Certification.

**Salary:** \$180 - \$205 per week

**Benefits:** Meals and housing provided.

**Description:** Serve as lifeguard at pool and water front. Assist with program activities, swim lessons, pool games, and evening activities as directed by the Aquatics Director. Help maintain all equipment and facilities including sand filtration system and pool chemicals. Two lifeguard positions must reside in camp.

## Camp Services Positions

### Facility Assistant

**When:** May 29, 2012 to August 31, 2012

**Minimum Age:** 18 YEARS OF AGE (21 PREFERRED)

**Special Requirements:** Clean Driving Record

**Salary:** \$200 - \$225 per week

**Benefits:** Meals included, housing available

**Description:** Responsible for 120-acre facility. Position includes ground care along with building upkeep. Knowledge of pool filtration, electrical, and plumbing is helpful. Janitorial duties are required of this job.

### Food Service Director

**When:** June 4, 2012 to August 24, 2012

**Minimum Age:** 21

**Special Requirements:** ServeSafe

**Salary:** Based on Experience

**Benefits:** Meals and Housing included.

**Description:** Plan, prepare, and order supplies for 3 meals a day standard and vegetarian (if necessary), for 50 - 70 campers/staff per meal. Maintain a sanitary kitchen and supervise Food Prep Assistant. Knowledge of health standards and Serve Safe Certification is needed.

### Food Prep Assistant

**When:** June 13th – August 27th

**Minimum Age:** 16

**Special Requirements:** ServeSafe

**Salary:** \$140-\$165 per week

**Benefits:** Meals included, housing available.

**Description:** Assist with kitchen duties including meal preparation, dishes and clean-up.

### Camp Health Officer

**When:** June 10, 2012 to August 24, 2012

**Minimum Age:** 21

**Special Requirements:** Registered Nurse, EMT, or Medic preferred, advanced First Aid required

**Salary:** \$350.00 to \$405.00 per week

**Benefits:** Meals included, housing available.

**Description:** Responsible for care of camp children in the age range of 5 to 17. Health officer will distribute medication as stated by parents, will be the primary care giver for all injuries that occur at camp and will be able to consult with staff on off camp trips.
